COVID RELIEF FUND

The Oklahoma Plan contributed \$1 million toward access to care and provider support in Oklahoma. A portion of the \$1 million was given to six organizations covering Oklahomans including Community Service Council of Tulsa and Heartline OKC, the Tulsa Area United Way, United Way of Central Oklahoma, Southern Plains Tribal Health Board (SPTHB) and MyHealth Access Network.

IMPROVING ACCESS TO CARE
