If you have other family members on the plan, each family member must meet their own individual deductible until the total amount of deductible expenses paid by all family members meets the overall family deductible. |
| Are there services covered before you meet your deductible? | Yes. Services from Indian health care provider, preventive health, primary care services and certain prescription drugs are covered before you meet your deductible. | This plan covers some items and services even if you haven't yet met the deductible amount. Does this plan provide Minimum Essential Coverage? Yes.

Minimum Essential Coverage generally includes plans, health insurance available through the Marketplace or other individual market policies, Medicare, Medicaid, CHIP, TRICARE, and certain other coverage. If you are eligible for certain types of Minimum Essential Coverage, you may not be eligible for the premium tax credit.
